

### Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

#### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

. After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

6. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of Institute for Plasma Research A/c ITER-India A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

2. The Bid document consist of following:

(i) Part-A(IA): Essential Eligibility Criteria, Part-A(IB): Instructions to bidders and Bid Submission format, Part-A(II): Scope of Supply & Work, Technical Specifications and Drawings, Part-A(III): Terms and Conditions of the Contract/Purchase Order uploaded as ATC document

ii) Part-B: Price Bid and Price Breakup (PDF)

3. The bidder shall submit duly filled, signed and stamped Price Break-up (PDF file) as per Annexure-B3 and Annexure-B4 on their letter head along with the Price Bid submission on GeM portal. The break-up shall be for the total price submitted on GeM portal.

4. Following categories of bidders are exempted from submission of EMD apart from the categories mentioned in clause (a) of the GeM bid and GeM GTC.

(i) Micro and Small Enterprises (only manufacturers for goods, except traders) registered with NSIC for the tendered Product

(ii) Seller or Service Provider registered with DPS, DAE.

Such bidder shall have to upload scanned copy of relevant registration document along with their bid.

5. The bid for seeking EMD exemption without submission of EMD and/ or without relevant/ valid document for availing exemption of EMD shall be treated as unresponsive bid and will not be taken up for evaluation.

6. Refer Table-2 of Part-A(IB) of ATC document for submission of all required documents as part of bid submission.

7. Clause No. 2.2 Pre-bid meeting has been added in the ATC document through this corrigendum. Pre-bid meeting will be held on 22nd April 2025 Time – 10.00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., remotely (online) via MS Teams at ITER-India, IPR. 10. Amendment is made in clause No. 4.4 Annexure-B4: Price Break-up for Spares of Part-A(IB). Refer to Annexure-B4: Price Break-up for Spares (Revised) of Part-A(IB) of ATC document.

11. Pre-bid clarifications are provided at Annexure-B8: Pre-bid Clarifications (consolidated) based on pre-bid meeting with bidders, added in Part-A(IB) of ATC document.

13. Clause No. 17.2 Arbitration, of Part-A(III) Terms and Conditions of the Contract shall be read as deleted.

## Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)

9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
