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DEFINITIONS

BENEFICIARIES: ITER–Organisation and ITER-India (INDA) and its authorised and mandated Suppliers.

BID/QUOTATION: shall mean the documents or offer or quotation submitted in response to this tender document by a bidder.

BIDDER/TENDERER shall mean the firm responding against this tender to empanel for carrying out logistics services.

CONTRACTOR: shall mean Logistic Service Provider (LSP) under Global Framework Contract of ITER Organization, which is currently DAHER International, France.

CONVENTIONAL EXCEPTIONAL LOADS (CEL): shall mean those loads that cannot be transported in a shipping container and may require a permit to transport over public roads regarding regulations about dimension and weight allowances.

CONVENTIONAL LOADS (CL): shall mean loads that can be transported in a shipping container by common commercial carrier/liner service or within standard trailers.

EMPANELMENT AGREEMENT: shall mean the agreement signed between qualified bidders of this tender and ITER-India, IPR (INDA), post evaluation of the bid and successful compliance to all the criteria of this tender.

FRAMEWORK CONTRACT: shall mean the Framework Contract No. IO/CFT/12/6000000085 signed between the ITER Organisation and the DAHER International, France.

HIGHLY EXCEPTIONAL LOADS (HEL): shall mean those loads that cannot be transported over French classic roads but have to travel over the ITER heavy haul itinerary from La Ponite Harbour to the ITER Site.

ITER ORGANISATION: shall mean the ITER International Fusion Energy Organisation established for the joint implementation of the ITER Project.

ITER-INDIA (IPR) has been established as a Domestic Agency to manage and provide the components and the supplies they have in their respective scope to IO, and the ITER - INDIA (hereinafter the “INDA”) is the Domestic Agency for India;

ITER PROJECT: shall mean the design, construction, assembly, testing, commissioning, ownership and maintenance of the ITER Project at a site located in Cadarache, France.

ITER SITE: shall mean the land leased to IO by the CEA by notarial deed with a possible extension on which the facilities necessary for the ITER Project are being constructed.

LOCAL LOGISTICS SERVICE PROVIDER (LLSP): shall mean the empanelled party(ies) of ITER-India, IPR against this tender and will also be a subcontractor (LLSP) of the Contractor (DAHER International, France), with which the Contractor has an exclusive partnership for the ITER Project

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defining, inter alia, the level of delegation granted by the Contractor to its Partner to sign and execute Task Orders in accordance with the terms of the contract.

LOAD: shall mean any Heavy Exceptional Loads, Conventional Exceptional Loads or Conventional Loads.

MANDATED SUPPLIER: shall mean any supplier who is in the contractual obligations to supply the deliverables of ITER-India.

PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT: shall mean the signed agreement between the empanelled party/(ies) (LLSP) and Contractor (currently M/s Daher International) in prescribed format for providing logistics services to INDA.

SERVICES: shall mean any service related to global logistics, transport including the insurance, the LLSP shall be required to perform against award of Task Order, as described in the Technical Specifications attached as Annex 1 to the Framework Contract.

SUBSIDIARY: shall mean any entity which controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with the Bidder/Logistics Service Provider. For purposes of this definition, “control” means (a) the power, direct or indirect, to cause the direction or management of such entity, whether by contract or otherwise, or (b) ownership of more than fifty percent (>50%) of the stock/shareholding or voting rights.

SUBCONTRACTOR: shall mean an economic operator who is under contract to the Bidder/LSP to perform any parts of the Services.

SUBCONTRACTOR’S STAFF: shall mean with respect to any Subcontractor, those directors, officers, employees, agents, and servants employed by such Subcontractor from time to time in discharging its duties under its subcontractor.

PROJECT CARGO: means any cargo comprising of equipment, fabricated items components of the manufactured equipment/system any of the given categories or mix of mechanical, electrical, instrumentation and control, electronics, SS pipes and large/heavy engineering machinery transported as containerised shipment and break-bulk shipment during the course of national or international transportation or Exportation-Importation.

TASK ORDER: shall mean the formal contractual agreement ordering a service, logistics or transport, insurance to be performed by the Contractor or its Local Partner.

THIRD PARTY SURVEYOR: shall mean an independent entity, acting in the role of verifier/arbitrator and being responsible for the controls at each handling point from the first loading at the Supplier’s dock or shop floor to the final offloading at the ITER site. The foregoing described responsibility also includes the control of the safety aspects of the itinerary before and during the transports.

SIC shall mean Safety important component.

PIC shall Protection Important Components

1.2 Introduction

ITER is a unique collaboration involving more than half of the global humanity. The ITER partners are the Peoples Republic of China, The European Union, India, Republic of Korea, Japan, Russian Federation and the United States of America. ITER will be built mostly through in-kind contributions from the participant countries Domestic Agencies (DAs) in the form of components manufactured by DAs and delivered/installed at ITER.

ITER-India is the Indian Domestic Agency (INDA) responsible for delivering India's contributions to the ITER Project. It is a specially empowered project within the Institute for Plasma Research, which is an aided institute under the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Government of India. ITER-India has 09 procurement packages to be delivered to the ITER Project. More information is available in the web site www.iterindia.in

DAHER International, France (DI) have been appointed as the Logistics Service Provider (LSP) to the ITER project with Global framework agreement. DAHER International, France will work with

Local Logistics Service Providers (LLSP) in the various member states of the ITER members (Domestic Authorities). These members also include India.

The broad responsibility is as follows:

The Local Logistics Service Provider (LLSP) shall perform the transportation and logistics services from ITER-India supplier's work/dock/shop floor until the loads are delivered at Quay at FOS-SUR-MUR (Grand Port Maritime de Marseille), France or any other place as defined in the Task Order placed by ITER-India, IPR.

From FOS-SUR-MUR (Grand Port Maritime de Marseille), France to ITER site (St. Paul Lez Durance), activities will be undertaken by DAHER International, France under the Global Framework Contract.

Thus, a close coordination with DAHER is mandatory.

The LLSP shall perform all requested Transport & Logistics Services from the Supplier's factory of INDA or any other place specified by INDA up to the delivery of loads Quay at FOS-SUR-MUR (Grand Port Maritime de Marseille), France or any other place as defined in the Task Order placed by ITER-India, IPR or at the Supplier's factory of receiving/consignee DA or ultimate destination.

LLSP will be considered for empanelment on the fulfilling the Essential Eligibility Criteria and acceptability of all terms and conditions defined in this tender document and all technical qualified bidders if agreeing to sign a Partnership Agreement with DAHER International, France (A draft template Agreement is attached as Annex-III), accepting the terms and conditions of the Implementation Agreement and tender. The successful bidders shall be included as empanelled local logistics service provider for ITER-India.

Bidders are responsible to familiarise themselves with the ITER Project and more specifically the contract arrangements from the enclosed documents. General information can also be found about the project on www.iter.org.

The bidders should note that ITER being an international collaboration they will uphold the prestige of India in matters of execution of the work under this contract.

1.3 Partnership Agreement and Commercial Arrangements

The agreement between DAHER International (LSP) and the LLSP shall include the following:

1.4 Scope of Work	
1.4.1.	The scope includes any service related to transport, logistics and insurance for ITER-India/ ITER Project from any point of origin in India and outside India to ITER-Site at Cadarache, France or any other location agreed in the respective Task Order to selected empanelled party as per process laid out in Commercial Arrangement. The Empanelled Local Logistics Service Provider will be called as the Local Logistic Service Provider (LLSP) to DAHER International, France.
1.4.2.	For detailed Scope of Work, the bidders are requested to refer notably Partnership Agreement, Global Transport, Services Technical Specifications and Commercial Arrangement of the Tender Document. The scope of work of the LLSP also includes following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. To provide competitive bid along with required documents against the enquiry along with the technical information issued by ITER-India against their logistics requirements. b. To provide Logistics, Transport and Insurance services by the selected LLSP based on the task order placed by ITER-India, IPR. c. To perform or cause to be performed all of the duties, obligations, responsibilities and covenants under this tender document and to be agreed in the form of Agreement; d. To complete the Services in accordance with the objectives set out in this tender document and to be agreed in the form of Agreement; e. 1.5 Important features of the Contract arrangements	
The Local Logistics Service Provider (LLSP) will sign a Partnership Agreement with DAHER International, France (DI) and he (the LLSP) will also sign a Local Agreement with ITER-India, PR which shall include the following requirements:	
1.5.1.	A number of commercial arrangements which shall include selected LLSP transmitting income received to DAHER International, France (only agreed percentage).
1.5.2.	The empanelment will be valid till 03 years from the date of signing of agreement. Purchaser reserve the right to extend the empanelment up to 02 years at the same terms and conditions.

1.5.3.	The partnership agreement shall be signed with Daher International will be made for the period till Dec 2024 and may be extended or culminate with Daher International contract with ITER Organisation.
1.5.4.	The Local Agreement will be made between ITER-India and /Local Logistics Service Provider in accordance with the terms and conditions of the tender documents including Implementation Agreement signed between DAHER International, France and ITER-India, Partnership Agreement between the LLSP and DAHER International, France.
1.5.5.	<p>Enquiry will be issued to the empaneled LLSP and offer will be asked against technical requirement of logistics, transport and insurance services to be provided for ITER-India, IPR consignment(s). 1.8 Procedure for obtaining Tender Documents

1.8.1	Tender Documents are available on ITER-India web site https://www.iterindia.in/tenders under “Opportunities for Industry/ITER India Tenders” menu select Public/Global Tender option for download
1.8.2	Alternatively, tender documents in hardcopy form can also be obtained directly (in person/by post) from the Sr. Officer (Purchase & Stores), ITER-India. The hard copy of Tender documents in this mode shall be issued up to 06-03-2023.
1.8.3	Issue of tender documents does not mean that a Bidder is automatically qualified to submit bids. ITER-India’s decision to consider as to whether a bidder has met with the EEC or not is final.

1.9 Bidder eligibility and other applicable conditions

Preference to Make In India (MII): Preference shall be given to Class-I Local Supplier as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India) Order 2017, as amended from time to time and its subsequent orders/notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific goods/products. The minimum local content to qualify as Class-I or Class-II Local Supplier is as per Government notification no. P-4501/2/2017-PP (BEII) dated 16.09.2020 issued by Ministry of Commerce & industry in this regard. Only Class-I Local Suppliers and Class-II Local Suppliers are eligible to bid for this tender. Non-Local Suppliers are not eligible to bid for this tender. Government notification no. P-4501/2/2017-PP (BEII) dated 16.09.2020 shall apply for this tender.

Class-I Local Suppliers and Class-II Local Suppliers will submit duly signed **Self-declaration under preference to Make in India order** on their letter head as per **Annexure-A5** Self Certification under preference to Make In India (MII) along with the offer/bid failing which bid may not be considered for further evaluation.

Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises will get precedence over Preference to Make In India.

No exemption with respect to “Bidder Turnover Criteria” and “Experience Criteria” will be given to a Micro or Small Enterprise.

No exemption with respect to “Bidder Turnover Criteria” and “Experience Criteria” will be given to a Start-up recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT).

Orders (F. NO.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July 2020) issued by the Government of India restricting procurement from bidders of certain countries which shares a land border with India shall apply to this tender.

Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (<https://mea.gov.in/india-and-neighbours.htm>), excluding countries as listed in the website of Ministry of External Affairs (<http://meadashboard.gov.in/indicators/92>), to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects (hereinafter called restricted countries’) shall be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered (<https://dpiit.gov.in/sites/default/files/Revised-Format-Bidders-31March2021.pdf>) with the Registration committee constituted by the Department for promotion of Industry and Internal Trade(DPIIT). The bidders shall enclose valid registration certificate along with their offer. Wherever the bids are received without accompanying the above said requisite certificate such offers shall be treated as incomplete and not considered.

Self-declaration regarding bidder not belonging from a country which shares/not shares land border with India as per **Annexure-A6** Eligibility Declaration should be uploaded on e-Tendering portal along with other documents.

1.10 Scope Appraisal Meeting

1.10.1.	The main objective of the Scope Appraisal Meeting is to ensure all the tender requirements that are specified through different tender documents have been clearly and correctly understood by all the potential/eligible bidders. Scope Appraisal Meeting will be held at ITER-India office, Ahmedabad tentatively on 21-02-2023 .
1.10.2.	The bidders will be required to register for the Scope Appraisal Meeting to confirm their participation and preference for the mode of the meeting (In person/On-line) in the prescribed format (refer Annexure-A1/Section: 3.0), on or before 18-02-2023 .
1.10.3.	The mode and format of the meeting : Preferred Mode : In Person Alternate Mode: On line through MS Teams meeting, meeting link shall be provided to the registered bidders who have opted for this mode
1.10.4.	Exact date and time for the Scope Appraisal Meeting shall be informed to all the bidders who have registered for the meeting. Request for changing date/time of meeting may not be considered.

1.10.6.	<u>The registered bidders are required to furnish in writing their pre-bid queries (both technical and commercial) latest by 18-02-2023. Outstanding queries and clarifications if any after the scope appraisal meeting shall be submitted preferably by 22-02-2023.</u> If the queries submitted by the bidders are in parts, then latest query should have all previous queries separated and marked properly, so that earlier information is available in consolidated form at a single point. The bidders are required to raise the queries if any, strictly as per the enclosed format (Annexure-A2/Section: 3) and send them to the Sr. Purchase Officer, ITER-India vide email (purchase@iterindia.in).
1.10.7.	Queries/clarification/information sought in any other manner shall not be responded
1.10.10.	The responses to a bidder's queries / clarifications / information will also be discussed and sent to all registered bidders. Scope Appraisal clarifications/responses to bidder's queries will also be uploaded to ITER-India web site under the "Tender- Public/Global Tenders" menu.
1.10.11.	In case a potential bidder makes any alternative suggestions with respect to the tender requirements, the same will be discussed and noted for further evaluation by ITER-India. However, ITER-India reserves the right to accept or reject such suggestions at its discretion.
1.10.12	Any modification(s) to the tender documents, which may become necessary as a result of the Scope Appraisal meeting, shall be uploaded to ITER-India web site and also communicated to all the bidders through email.
1.11 Amendments to tender documents	
1.11.1	The purchaser reserves the right to issue any amendments, clarifications, etc. to the tender documents, giving reasonable time, and prior to the bid opening. Such amendments, clarifications etc., shall be given due consideration by the bidders while submitting the bids and invariably enclose such documents as a part of the bid. All such amendments, clarifications, etc., shall be uploaded to ITER-India website. The purchaser will bear no responsibility or liability arising out of non-receipt of the same in time or otherwise.
1.12 Tender Fee & EMD	
1.12.1.	The completed bids should be submitted along with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) as per the following details referring to the bid submission format
1.12.2.	Tender Fee: No tender fee is applicable for this tender
1.12.3.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): Bids must be submitted along with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for INR 10,00,000.00 (Indian Rupees Ten Lakh only) by a Demand Draft or through RTGS or through NEFT (National Electronic Funds Transfer) as per the details mentioned below.
1.12.4	The DD shall be drawn in favour of Institute for Plasma Research A/c ITER-India and payable at Ahmedabad, INDIA. Bidder's name and tender number shall be indicated on the reverse side of the Demand Draft. The DD shall be drawn from State Bank of India (SBI) or from any of the Nationalized banks or one of the banks namely ICICI Bank, IDBI Bank, HDFC Bank and AXIS Bank. 1.12.8	EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned, without any interest, within thirty days after completion of technical evaluation / declaration of results of the tender. The bidder shall submit along with Part-A (Techno-Commercial Part) of the bid their account details, IFSC code, the name & address of his bankers and copy of cancelled cheque for refund of EMD and payment as applicable.
1.12.9	The EMD shall be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends or impairs or derogates from the submitted tender in any respect within the period of bid validity.
