

### Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

#### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Institute for Plasma Research A/c ITER-India payable at Gandhinagar.  
Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.
2. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Payment online through RTGS / internet banking in Beneficiary name Institute for Plasma Research A/c ITER-India Account No. 30360884053 IFSC Code SBIN0010864 Bank Name State Bank of India Branch address IPR Bhat Branch, Gandhinagar-382428.  
Bidder to indicate bid number and name of bidding entity in the transaction details field at the time of on-line transfer. Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the Online Payment Transfer along with bid.

  2. Due to size constrain of Annexure-T1 transportation drawing of all 3 ACBs, bidder are requested to download drawing from ITER-India website following link : <https://www.iterindia.in/tenders> under Public/Global Tender category.

  3. Part-B - Price Bid Format

  5. Bidder needs to submit valid documentary proof as per evaluation criteria mentioned in Part-A(II). The bid complying with evaluation criteria shall only be considered for further evaluation.
  6. Bidder need to submit "Password Protected" Price Bid breakup as per format given in Part-B.(attached in buyer added bid specific ATC document). Password will be asked by Purchaser at the time of order placement from successful bidder only. Price Breakup shall form an integral part of the order.

Bidder are requested to note Means of Transport as per Section – 2 – Scope of Work of Part-A(I): Technical specifications –to be read as “By Road (from collection point to Marghera port, Italy) and By Sea from Marghera port, Italy to FOS Sur Mer (GPMM), France on **Geared/ Gearless coaster vessel**” instead of existing.

15. Bidder are requested to note that Note-2 of Price-Bid format as per Part-B in Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC & Note-2 of Unprice Bid Format as per Annexure-A4 to be read as “The profit sharing 50:50 between the successful bidder and Daher would on Part B\_Price Bid Format Table I ACBs transport (3 ACBs) Sr. No. 6 {Sub Total of sr.no (1 to 5)}. Bidders should keep in mind that the 7% Gross Profits & Overheads value is above the bid amount & is not a part of the price bid format. Hence, as per the arrangement, 3.5% of the profits above the bid value will remain with the successful bidder and 3.5% is to be reimbursed to Daher” instead of existing. **Revised Price Bid format Part-B is attached herewith in ATC document. Same revised format to be used for unprice bid format (Annexure-A4)**

18. The main change in Scope of work in Part-A(I) is as follows.

- i. Transportation of 3 Nos. ACBs in single batch completely through any one out of below two options:
  - (a) via road transportation from SIMIC, Italy to ITER Organization, France or

- (b) in multimodal (road and sea) transportation from SIMIC Italy to FOS Sur MER France in close coordination with M/s Daher International France.
- ii. Any one option out of above two needs to be proposed by the bidder based on the feasibility of the ACB transportation and based on the size and weight of each ACB.
- iii. Based on the option proposed by the bidder, appropriate table in price bid format (Part-B) needs to be quoted

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
